**Important: If the assignment was completed during the school year, students should TRY to improve their score! Teachers will put the summer date range to pull scores.**

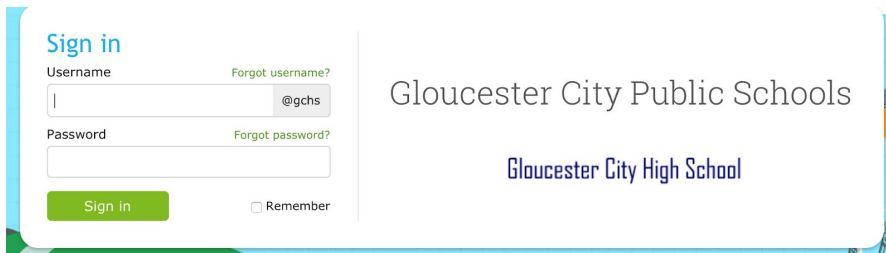

2. Enter your username and password in the top right corner of the page



- a. You must be logged in to receive credit

3. Click on the GRADE LEVEL you have just COMPLETED (ex.: **5<sup>th</sup> going into 6<sup>th</sup> will click on 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**)
  4. Please complete the topics below until you reach a Smartscore of 80 or have worked for 30 minutes on that topic.
  5. Once all topics are completed, you are finished!
