Math Instructions

1. Go to <https://www.ixl.com/signin/gchs> or click IXL Math from the student menu on the CSS webpage
1. Enter your username and password in the top right corner of the page
 - a. **You must be logged in to receive credit**
 - b. If you forget your username and password, please call the main office and ask or email: Dee Driscoll. (ddriscoll@gcsd.k12.nj.us)
2. Click on the GRADE LEVEL you have just COMPLETED (ex.: 1st going into 2nd will click on 1st Grade)
3. Please complete the topics/skills below until you reach a Smartscore of 80 or have worked for 30 minutes on that topic. This must be completed before school begins in September)
4. Once all eight skills are completed, you are finished!

There is nothing to submit. Teachers will be able to track your time/days/dates spent on assignments.
