Summer School Meeting Dates:

Gloucester City Jr. Sr. High School is open **Monday** through **Thursday** for summer hours.

June: 28th, 29th and 30th

July: 1st, 6th, 7th, 8th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 26th, 27th, 28th and 29th

August: 2nd

Make-Up Days For Absences: August 3rd and 4th.

5th Meeting Date For Health I - IV will be on August 3rd

Class Times:

8:00 AM - 11:00 AM and/or 11:30 AM - 2:30 PM

Attendance: Students are not permitted to be absent more than 2 days. All absences up to 2 days **MUST** be made up on August 2nd and 3rd. Any student absent a 3rd day will not receive credit or tuition refund, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Late To Class: A lateness to class of 10 or more minutes or leaving early 10 minutes or more is considered an absence, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Credits: It is the responsibility of county tuition students to ensure that their home based school will accept the credits from Gloucester City Jr. Sr. High School's Summer Program.

5 Credit Courses require (60 hours) of summer school attendance. **Physical Education** requires 2880 minutes (48 hours) of summer school attendance.

2010 Summer School Student Behavior

Gloucester City Jr. Sr. High School will not tolerate any discipline infractions of any student attending summer school. **Policies and procedures as per Gloucester City Jr. Sr. High School's Student Discipline Code will be followed.**

Infractions listed below will result in the student being immediately dismissed from summer school and a forfeiture of tuition and course credit:

1. Bullying and Harassment
2. Verbal Assault to another student or employee
3. Fighting
4. Academic Dishonesty
5. Leaving Class without Permission
6. Tampering with School Equipment
7. Under the Influence of Alcohol, Drugs, Steroids
8. Possession of Alcohol, Drugs, Steroids, Weapons
9. Insubordination
10. Use of cell phones and/or other electronic devices while in class
11. Smoking on School Grounds
12. Theft

Dress Code: Students are expected to be clean, neatly attired and that their dress is such as not to be immediately disruptive to other students or the summer school program. Students inappropriately dressed will be excused from school and an absence will be recorded. The administration reserves the right to make the final decision on all attire.
