In preparation for the upcoming school year, we encourage students entering 7th and 8th grade to stay engaged with math through consistent practice of essential skills. This helps prevent summer learning loss and supports a smoother transition into more advanced math content in the fall.

In alignment with the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) for Mathematics, we recommend that students focus on practicing the following key math skills over the summer:

For Students Entering 7th Grade:


- Operations with fractions, decimals, and integers
- Proportional relationships and ratios
- Solving one-step and two-step equations
- Understanding and calculating percentages

For Students Entering 8th Grade:

- Solving multi-step equations and inequalities
- Working with exponents and scientific notation
- Analyzing data and understanding basic statistics

We encourage families to incorporate math practice into weekly routines using real-life scenarios (such as budgeting, cooking, or measuring), and math games. Additionally, students also have access to online programs for skill development.
